Ask Jesus About Friendship

John 14:26

“But the Father will send the Friend in My name to help you. The Friend is the Holy Spirit. He will teach you all things. He will remind you of everything I have said to you.”

How many times a day do you ask a question? And when you do, who do you ask? When you want the new, coolest toy, who do you ask to buy it for you? When you want permission to do something, who do you get the okay from? If the Math’s too difficult, who do you turn to for help?

Just as we turn to our parents or grandparents, aunts or uncles, teachers and leaders to answer these questions for us, we can look to God to show us how to live from day to day. When it comes to friendship, the Bible has something to say on the subject!
